

## Tip Leads To 3 Arrests, \$800,000 In Drugs

**UNION TOWNSHIP** -- A tip to Union Township police led to a big drug bust on Sunday.

Police said they received word that a car carrying thousands of prescription drug pills would be passing Eastgate on Sunday afternoon.

Officers spotted a Chevy Lumina that matched the tip's description and pulled it over just after 3 p.m.

Police said that inside a hidden compartment, they found thousands of Vicodin, methodone and OxyContin pills.

"Hopefully by removing these pills, we've saved a life. These pills are common pills that people overdose on and die," Lt. Scott Gaviglia said.

The drugs could have been worth as much as \$800,000 on the street, police said.

Three people were arrested in connection with the case, but their names have not been released.
