

Son dead of overdose; father charged in drug robbery

A man accused of helping to rob an Ogden pharmacy with his son faces up to life in prison. His son later overdosed on pain killers allegedly taken in the theft.

Don David Mitchell, 55, was charged Monday with aggravated robbery, a first-degree felony. Ogden police say on Friday Mitchell drove his son, Larry Kenneth Mitchell, to a pharmacy so the younger Mitchell could rob it of prescription pain medication by threatening employees with a gun. The pair ingested the medication and Larry Mitchell overdosed and died. On Monday night, Mitchell was in the Weber County jail in lieu of \$20,000 bail.
